ABOUT THE HOST INSITUION

The Agriculture University, Kota (AUK) is situated in *Hadoti* region of Rajasthan. The university jurisdiction is spread over in six district of the state. It has in its ambit 9.98 per cent geographical area, 12.67 per cent human population, 9.4 per cent livestock population, 31.59 per cent forest area and 20.6 net sown area of state. The University has the onus of agricultural development in South-Eastern Rajasthan which experiences climatic conditions varying from dry to humid across different regions.

The College of Horticulture and Forestry established during the year 2004, is a constituent unit of the AU, Kota. Presently, the College offers two undergraduate programmes; namely B.Sc. Horticulture and B.Sc. Forestry; M. Sc. Horticulture degree programmes in four broad disciplines namely; Fruit Science, Vegetable Science, Floriculture and Landscaping and Post Harvest Technology; M.Sc. Forestry degree programme and Ph. D. programme in Fruit Science shall commence w.e.f. academic session 2017-18. The college campus sprawls amidst the *Gomati Sagar* and *Mundelikheri* dam. it spread over 135 ha area put forth under administrative as well as various in-house amenities besides instructional and research activities based on fruits, vegetables, floricultural crops besides other horticultural and forestry crops. In pursuit of excellence, the college has the asylum in form of Modern Laboratories, Forest museum & Interpretation centre, Computer lab with internet facilities, Boy's hostel, Girl's hostel, Farmer's hostel. Tissue culture laboratory, Herbal Garden, Protected cultivation unit, Model Nursery and Propagation Unit, and also Farms with all modern agricultural implements/machineries. Fruits and Vegetables processing hall, Vegetables seed processing unit, Playground etc. are other infrastructural strength to the college.

It is a matter of academic gratification that the students from the college incessantly secured positions in JRF examination carried out by ICAR, New Delhi. The college is a favourite destination for students pursuing UG/PG degree in the field of Horticulture and Forestry.

ABOUT THE WINTER SCHOOL

India is the second largest producer of fruits and vegetables after China. The country produces a variety of fruits ranging from tropical/subtropical to temperate nature across varied biotic realm of the country. Hitherto, the average productivity of fruit is 11.7 t/ha as against 22.4 t/ha in Indonesia and 22.2 t/ha. in USA.

There is scope of almost two times transformation of fruit yield than what is being produced at present. It can be realized opting various measures. HRD improvement is one of them.

The winter school will have all focus on qualitative improvement and updation of teachers, researchers and extension specialists in the domain area of hi-tech fruit production. Every attempt shall be made to have orientation of participants to contemporary matters in hi-tech fruit production. The school will serve as unique avenues for interaction and exchange of experiences among participants and professionals to make education, research and extension more relevant. During the winter school contents shall be delivered through theory and lecture sessions. Faculty of eminence from AU, Kota as well as SAUs/ ICAR units shall form resource persons for the winter school. Besides lectures on the relevant contents, labs visit, progressive farmers' farm visit, field trip etc. shall form vital component of winter school. Formal discussion from among participants shall be also arranged to make participants aware of the basic practices and scenario of fruit production across broad horizon of the country.

Eligibility

The personnel with master degree in Horticulture and allied disciplines working under SAUs/CAUs/ICAR recognized institutions not below the rank of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the subject-Horticulture, Soil Science, Agronomy, Forestry, Basic Sciences and other concerned disciplines are eligible to apply for participation in the winter school.

The applicant will be selected subject to fulfilment of eligibility requirements as set forth by the ICAR, New Delhi.

How to apply

The interested candidate should apply online using CBP portal through <http://iasri.res.in/cpb> or under link Capacity Building program at <http://icar.org.in> steps for submission of online application form are as follows:

1. To create user ID use "Create New Account" link on home page. login using your user Id & password. if you have forgotten password, click on "Forgotten passwords" link.
2. After login, choose this training under SWS category, and click on "Participate in Training" link and fill proforma. after filling the online application, fill 'draft/postal' order details and take printout of application and get it approved by the competent authority of the organizations. upload the scanned copy of application through CBP portal. in Addition send hard copy to the Course Director of the summer school along with DD/PO
3. the applicant has to pay non-refundable registration fee of Rs. 50/- (Rs. Fifty only) as DD/PO in the favour of "Comptroller " AU, Kota payable at Kota Rajasthan.
4. Advance copy of application can be sent by email to Course Director/ Course Coordinator .
5. The selected candidate will be informed by email portal well in advance.
6. Once candidate are intimated about their selection for their training, they need to confirm their acceptance by last date.

Boarding and lodging

Participant will be provided free boarding and lodging facilities as per ICAR norms.

Participants are requested not to bring family member as the accommodations is strictly limited to trainees only. Participant are requested to inform the Course Director / Course Coordinator well in advance about their arrival and departure including date and time for the convenience of their stay during the Winter School.
